Shift availability varies seasonally, workload and available shifts increase between September and April annually.

3. Current unrestricted class 5 driver's license and ability to follow safe vehicle operation and traffic procedures for aerodromes
4. Computer literacy and ability to maintain electronic records
5. A strong commitment to safety and safe work practices and a willingness to promote Avisure's safety culture
6. Ability to acquire a Non-restricted PAL (firearms license)
7. Ability to acquire a Restricted Area Identification Card (RAIC)
8. Ability to acquire a YVR airside driving permit (D-AVOP)

2. Higher education or qualification in wildlife biology/ecology/conservation or equivalent experience
3. Ability to acquire Aircraft Radio/Telephone Operators Proficiency

6. Experience/license in use and maintenance of small watercraft.
